Moondog's Summer Snapper Tournament

Tournament Rules:

- FISHING DATE : Saturday July 1st – July 30th 2017
- PAYOUT: Amount of cash awards will be based on the number of boats entering the tournament. Cash prizes will be adjusted up or down depending on participation. 100% of the entry fees will be awarded out to the winners minus any unforeseen expenses to the Marina.

- REGISTRATION: Registration will be open from now until 6am on July 1st. There will be no captain's meeting. Registration will be \$250 per boat and side-pots will be \$100 per side-pot. YOU MUST ENTER THE TOURNAMENT IN ORDER TO ENTER THE SIDE-POTS. All fees must be paid in cash. You must register with Mark, Irene, or anyone else in the ship store from 6am-6pm.
- SNAPPER RULES: Boat captains will only be able to weigh-in snapper on days when snapper fishing is eligible (See TPWD rules) until 1159pm of that day. Mark is the weigh master for this tournament. Snapper weighed in during business hours can be done by anyone in the ship-store, if Mark is not present. Snapper that come in after 6pm when the ship-store is closed must be weighed in AND have a picture taken by a senior member of the Surfside Marina Staff as well as the form filled out and signed by the Boat captain and the Surfside Marina employee. Boat captains must get this done or their catch can be deemed ineligible. Tournament will be an aggregate of your 4

biggest snapper for the month. Total weight at 1159pm on July 30th will be declared the winner. You may weigh in multiple times during the month.

- **SIDE-POT RULES:** We will have 5 side-pot fish (the ones that Moondog hated to clean the most and Snapper). All side-pots prizes will be based on entry of each side-pot with 100% of the entry money going to the first place only. Entry for each division will be \$100. Side-pot will be the largest fish winning. In case of a tie, same rules apply as above with the tiebreaker going to the fish that was weighed in first. Side pot fish can be weighed at anytime during the month but after hour rules still apply.
SIDE-POT FISHES ARE: Snapper, Kingfish, Ling, Dolphin and Barracuda

- **OTHER RULES:**
 - All fish must be caught on rod and reel only. No electric reels allowed to be used on ANY of the fish. We are on the honor system here.
 - Everyone on boat must have valid fishing license. Must be able to show proof upon request. If any member on the boat cannot show proof at the time of weigh in, that fish is ineligible.
 - Boats are the entry into the tournament, not individuals. So the crews can change from week to week, but not the boat.
 - All fish must be in acceptable condition. No frozen, mutilated, or fish not deemed to be “fresh” will not be accepted.
 - Official scale will be the flat scale located on the porch of the main building. It will be the captain’s responsibility to get the fish, SSM employee and SSM employee camera to the patio for verification. Forms will be located in the ship-store and in Mark’s office.
 - Boats for hire are ineligible for this tournament.

Any rules violations will be subject to disqualification.

Mark will be the sole judge and his decision will be final.
